

Transplantation - the bottom line:

Patients reclaim a useful and healthy life

Large savings to the health care system

BC & Yukon Branch

Barriers:

Availability of transplantable organs

Low usable rate of donated organs

Perceived difficulty in registering

BC & Yukon Branch

Savings following Transplant: \$43,000 per patient in first year In following years savings are higher - \$63,000

Total savings to health system over 5 years: \$59 million for 200 transplants/year

BC & Yukon Branch

Transplantation:

A long term option

Not a cure

Patient reclaims a productive and healthy life

First year cost - \$27,000

Subsequent years - just \$7,000

Best patient option

BC & Yukon Branch

Two Therapy options:

Dialysis

Immediate but short term option

50% don't survive beyond 4 years

3,000 on dialysis in BC

75 City of Nanaimo residents on dialysis

Cost to system is \$70,000 per patient per year
