Oliver Woods Park recently expanded with an additional 4.3 hectares of land added. Oliver Woods Park is now 7.3 hectares and is zoned PRC-3.

Formalized on March 12, 2013, the City of Nanaimo and School District #68 entered into a process to exchange select parcels of land. The exchange included 4.3 hectares of additional land

added to Oliver Woods Park, as well as Harewood Sports Field along Fifth Street, and 3.0 hectares at May Richards Bennett Pioneer Park. This land exchange was a result of a partnership with Nanaimo Ladysmith Public Schools. Building Community Partnerships has been identified as one of the strategic priorities in the City of Nanaimo's Corporate Strategic Plan.
