Existing Tree Management Bylaw Problems / Challenges

- Adopted 1993
- No changes / amendments
- Limited ability to protect trees

Key Components

Exemptions

• Expand and clarify exemptions for tree removal and/or pruning

Removal Criteria

• Establish new terms of reference for evaluating removal permits

Clarify Application Requirements

· Provide detailed information on application requirements

Conditions

 Allows for permits to be issued with conditions (ie. timing, notification, clean-up of sites)

Replacement

 Provides replacement options and establishes ratios, sizes, preferred species

Security

Establishes mechanisms to ensure proposed tree replacement or retention is successful

Application Fees

- from \$25 to \$50
- from \$2 to \$10 / tree
- \$100 for removal of significant tree

Penalty

Establishes a fine schedule for work without or contrary to a permit





Key Components



Exemptions

Expand and clarify exemptions for tree removal and/or pruning

Removal Criteria

Establish new terms of reference for evaluating removal permits

Clarify Application Requirements

· Provide detailed information on application requirements

Conditions

 Allows for permits to be issued with conditions (ie. timing, notification, clean-up of sites)

Replacement

 Provides replacement options and establishes ratios, sizes, preferred species

Security

 Establishes mechanisms to ensure proposed tree replacement or retention is successful

Application Fees

- from \$25 to \$50
- from \$2 to \$10 / tree
- \$100 for removal of significant tree

Penalty

 Establishes a fine schedule for work without or contrary to a permit
