- a) <u>Nanaimo Cultural Plan "Vision for Culture" Stakeholder Feedback Session (2013-JAN-10):</u> All City Committees and Commissions have been invited to provide feedback on the new Nanaimo Cultural Plan on 2013-JAN-10, from 5:00 pm to 6:30 pm at the Nanaimo Museum. - b) <u>World-Class Water Expert Speaks at VIU (2013-FEB-04)</u>: Margaret Catley Carlson, former vice-president of the Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA) and Assistant Secretary General to the United Nations, will give an open lecture on 2013-FEB-04 from 5:30 pm to 7:00 pm at Vancouver Island University (Building 356, Room 109). 7. Ongoing Business

a) <u>Review of Riparian Setback Variance Policy:</u>

At the 2012-DEC-12 ACES meeting, ACES had asked Staff to provide an information memo, as well as invite G. Noble, Development Approval Planner to the meeting, to provide information on the City's current riparian setback variance policy and process.

At the 2012-DEC-17 Council meeting, D. Brennan put forward the following motion which carried unanimously: *"that the Planning Department review the riparian setback variation policy, in consultation with the Advisory Committee on Environmental Sustainability (ACES), the Design Process Review Committee (DPRC) and the development community, and forward any resulting recommendations for change for Council's consideration."*

Due to this motion and the process that must take place because of it, the Planning Department will review the watercourse bylaw and setback variance process (currently in progress) and then consult with ACES and DPRC (around February). Consulting both groups at once will ensure fair and balanced sharing of information, and an opportunity for everyone to hear input and ideas from all perspectives.

R. Lawrance confirmed with ACES that their questions (as listed in the 2012-NOV-14 Minutes) are currently being considered by management and will be reported back on shortly. Further details will be provided at the next meeting.

b) Work Plan 2013 – Topics & Issues selection:

Based on feedback from the last meeting, Staff presented a draft work plan for 2013 and reviewed it with the Committee. The following suggestions were made:

- Add a new item for the Community Sustainability Action Plan and flag it as "ongoing". Make note of outcomes, including public education and promotion opportunities, building partnerships, contacts and deliverables.
- Change the last sentence in the report to: "In addition, the Committee will expect to address
 additional topics or tasks that fall within the mandate of ACES <u>or</u> that may be referred to by
 Council".

It was moved and seconded that the above noted amendments be applied to the 2013 work plan. The motion was carried.

Staff will make the above suggested changes and will seek ACES' endorsement at the next meeting.

8. New Business

- a) <u>Green Nanaimo Awards Review Categories/Timeline:</u> Staff distributed a copy of the brochure used for the 2011 awards and asked ACES to provide comment or suggested revisions.
 - Youth Award now called "Jeff Thomas Environmental Youth Award"
 - Award with Distinction now called the "Mervyn Wilkinson Award With Distinction"
 - Discontinue "Green Design" award (allow the Design Advisory Panel (DAP) to carry on with that award)
 - List winners of 2011 award on the brochure and use updated photos
 - Place list of past winners on City's website

An updated timeline and brochure will be presented at the next meeting for approval.
