1. **Call to Order**

Chair D. Brennan called the meeting to order at 5:10 pm.

2. Approval of Agenda & Late Items

- b) Judo Club Building Reconsider adding to register (C. Meutzner on behalf of J. Stannard) J. Stannard was unable to attend the meeting due to health reasons. On her behalf, C. Meutzner noted her interest in reconsidering the Judo Club Building (110 Machleary Street) for addition to the heritage register (in light of value placed on it and the surrounding site by Vancouver Island University during their recent anniversary celebrations).

5. New Business

a) <u>Review Draft Work Plan for 2013</u>

C. Sholberg presented the Commission with a report containing a draft work plan for 2013, as well as a review of the 2012 work plan. New items for 2013 include completion of an Old City heritage walk brochure and photo inventory.

The Commission requested that a review of the heritage plaque policy be added to the 2013 work plan.

Staff has recently noticed reluctance from boutique mortgage lenders to sign-off on heritage covenants required for heritage home grants. This has resulted in a couple of the Commission-approved grant applicants being unable to register their covenant and collect grant money.

It was suggested that the mortgage lenders may be afraid of the covenant having priority over their mortgage. If the City of Nanaimo could add the covenant to the property within asking the lenders for "priority", the lenders may be more receptive. C. Sholberg will discuss this concept with the City's lawyers and report back to the Commission with more information.

It was moved and seconded that the 2013 work plan be approved with the above noted amendments. The motion was carried.

6. Ongoing Business

a) Memo to Council re Demolition of Colliery Dam & Spillway:

Staff noted that the memo was received by Council as requested by the Commission. Council is currently looking at other alternatives to removing the dam and spillway (replace or rehabilitate) and has undertaken a \$60,000 study in order to do so. More information will be provided as it becomes available.

b) Heritage Week (Feb 18-24): Heritage Summit (Feb 20) – Update:

The theme of this year's heritage week is "Heritage Homes and Neighbourhoods". The Summit is scheduled for 2013-FEB-20 at the Nanaimo Museum. Invitations and advertising will go out in late January. A speaker has not yet been confirmed, but the presentation will likely focus on the heritage week theme.
