(a) Mr. Todd Wood, Independent Order of Odd Fellows, Black Diamond Lodge #5, 2505 Blackcomb Place, Nanaimo, BC, V9T 6A3, presenting to the Parks Committee with regard to the donation of a clock by the organization to the City of Nanaimo.

Mr. Wood referred to the material package and reviewed the history of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows and their contribution to the community of Nanaimo since the late 1800's primarily working within the mining industry. He discussed the Organization's challenge in retaining members and the need to maintain six members in order to maintain lodge status. He advised of the recent donations of \$50,000 to School District #68 and \$50,000 to the Hospital Foundation following the sale of a property on Prideaux Street. Historically the organization donated funds to the City of Nanaimo to become incorporated. They would now like to donate \$50,000.00 for the installation of a clock valued at \$30,000.00 and installation valued at \$20,000.00. The City of Nanaimo would provide power to the installation site. Two installation sites were discussed; McGregor Park and in front of the Great National Land Building at 17 Church Street. The clock is manufactured in cast aluminum and is 17 feet in height with a face on all four sides. It can be set to chime at specific hours. The members of the Order of Oddfellows Organization would prefer to install at McGregor Park with a bench. They are asking for a recommendation from the Committee back to the Commission for installation location of the clock.

Discussion was held with regard to the pros and cons of the location options, as presented in the report. As well, correspondence received from DNBIA regarding the possible installation location was reviewed. Further discussions will be held with representatives from the Independent Order of Odd Fellows, Black Diamond Lodge #5.

It was moved and seconded that the Parks Committee recommend that the Parks, Recreation and Culture Commission approve the donation of a clock from the Independent Order of Odd Fellows, Black Diamond Lodge #5, to be sited at McGregor Park. The motion carried unanimously.
