- 2. Update the Travel Grant funding criteria to include an allowance for competitors traveling within BC to eligible Provincial, National or International competitions up to a maximum of \$50 per person to a maximum of \$1,000 per team;
- 3. Add additional criteria ensuring the groups have applied for provincial funding from their Provincial Sport Organization if applicable; and,
- Evaluate multi-year applications on a case by case basis to ensure the program does not become an ongoing or only source of travel fund.

A friendly amendment was made to amend point 2. of the recommendation to read, "Update the Travel Grant funding criteria to include an allowance for competitors traveling off Vancouver Island, within BC, to eligible Provincial, National or International competitions up to a maximum of \$50 per person to a maximum of \$1,000 per team."

A friendly amendment was made to amend point 3. of the recommendation to read, "Add additional criteria ensuring the groups have applied for funding from their Provincial and/or National Sport Organization if applicable."
