## CALL THE OPEN MEETING TO ORDER:

The Special Grant Allocations Meeting of the Cultural Committee was called to order at 4:03 p.m.

2. BACKGROUND ON THE SYMPHONY REQUEST TO COMMISSION – RICHARD HARDING.

Mr. Harding provided information on the motion that was passed by the Parks, Recreation and Culture Commission and has been sent to Council:

It was moved and seconded that the Parks, Recreation and Culture Commission recommend that Council approve:

- the total amount of funding per year as a line item to the Vancouver Island Symphony of \$85,000;
- a Higher Service Level Request for the Vancouver Island Symphony in the amount of \$25,000;
- that \$60,000 from the Cultural Operating Grants be used to fund the Vancouver Island Symphony each year; and,
- the amount be reviewed in three years.

Mr. Harding advised that as Council budget discussions will not be held for some time, the Cultural Committee should proceed as they normally would in the Grant Allocation process without those amounts and options being included in the deliberation process.
