1. BYLAW NO. 4500.005

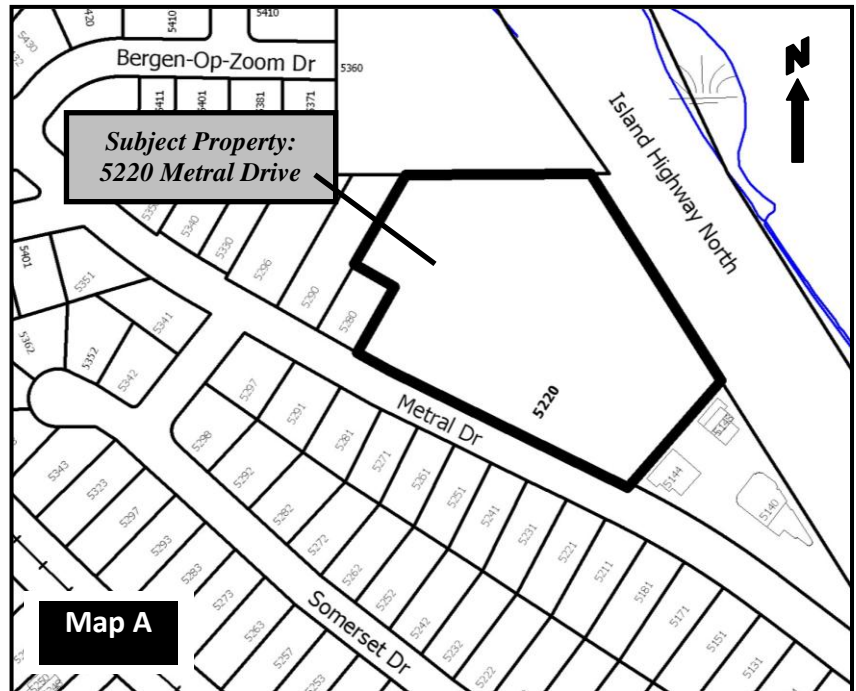
Purpose: To amend the existing Comprehensive Development District Zone Five.

Location(s): 5220 Metral Drive

This bylaw, if adopted, will amend the Comprehensive Development District Zone Five (CD5) of "ZONING BYLAW 2011 NO. 4500" in order to make changes to the existing Comprehensive Development Plan.

The subject property is legally described as LOT 1, SECTION 4, RANGE 4, WELLINGTON DISTRICT, PLAN 17570 EXCEPT THOSE PARTS IN PLANS 18750, 20202, 22823, AND 24971 and is shown on Map A.
