RE: PRE-TRANSPORTATION PLAN PUBLIC INFORMATION PROCESS

STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION:

- 1. That the Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC) approves the plan for an Open House and media releases before and after the Open House.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The TAC passed a resolution on 2011-Apr-07 to ask staff to draft a pre-plan consultation process for discussion at the next meeting.
