At the Inaugural meeting of the Parks Recreation and Culture Commission held 2009-FEB-25, the matter of the request from Mr. Pat Barron of 1911 Valley Oak Drive, Nanaimo, B.C. V9R 6N1 to Nanaimo City Council for placement of a bench and plaque at Maffeo Sutton Park to commemorate the 14 volunteers of the concerned Citizens Committee whose work resulted in the retention of Maffeo Sutton Park as public land, and which had been referred by Council to the Commission was reviewed. The Parks, Recreation and Culture Commission referred this matter to the Parks Committee for review of alternatives to a bench and plaque.

It was moved and seconded that the Parks Committee recommend that the Parks, Recreation and Culture Commission support Mr. Barron's proposal and have a plinth and plaque, subject to confirmation of location, erected to recognize the

Concerned Citizens Committee for the preservation of the lands now known as Maffeo Sutton Park. The motion carried unanimously.

(b) Steps at Pipers Lagoon.

<u>Staff Recommendation:</u> That the Parks Committee direction is sought.

At the Inaugural meeting of the Parks Recreation and Culture Commission held 2009-FEB-25, the matter of a letter from Mr. Robert H. Dean of 3699 Hammond Bay Road, Nanaimo, B.C. V9T 1G2 to Mayor Ruttan requesting that some form of steps be carved into the rocks, or be built, and placed to give full access to the full peninsula was reviewed. The Parks, Recreation and Culture Commission referred this matter to the Parks Committee for their review and advice.

It was moved and seconded that Staff meet with Mr. Dean on site and return to the Committee with recommendations following this meeting. The motion carried unanimously.
