Nanaimo African Heritage Society

A late application was received from the African Heritage Society on 2008-NOV-12, 11 days after the 2008-NOV-01 deadline. The Cultural Committee is not in support of granting funds to late applicants. The Cultural Committee had recommended that the Parks, Recreation and Culture Commission not recommend the African Heritage Society for an Arts and Cultural Event Grant because of the late nature of their application.
