1. CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order at 7:02 p.m.

2. APPEAL: BOV00224

APPLICANT: Eli Kekich / Troy Heringa

LOCATION: Legal Description: LOT 68, SECTION 15A, WELLINGTON DISTRICT, PLAN 33755 Civic Address: 570 Cumberland Place

PURPOSE: The applicant is requesting that::

- 1. The front yard setback requirement be reduced from 6 metres (19.69 feet) to 2.29 metres (7.52 feet); and
- 2. The maximum height requirement be increased from 8.25 metres (27.06 feet) to 9.25 metres (30.34 feet);

in order to construct a single family dwelling. This represents a setback variance of 3.71 metres (12.17 feet) and a height of building variance of 1 metre (3.28 feet).

ZONING REGULATIONS:

This property is included in the Single Family Residential Zone (RS-1) and the appeal seeks to vary the following provisions of the "City of Nanaimo Zoning Bylaw 4000":

Board of Variance Minutes 2004-December-16th Page 1 "Section 6.1.6.1 – Yard Requirements A front yard of not less than 6 metres (19.69 feet) shall be provided"

"Section 6.1.7.1. – Height of Buildings

The height of a principal building shall not exceed the maximum height shown in the following table:

Roof Pitch	Maximum Height
A sloped roof (> than 4:12)*	8.25 metres (27.06 feet)

*for an area of at least 80% of all roof surfaces measured in plan view."

Mr. Raoul Lussier and Mrs. Lois Lussier (550 Cumberland Pl.), Mr. Roy Wagner and Mrs. Judy Latham submitted letters in opposition to this appeal.
