

Located at the southern boundary of the City of Nanaimo at the junction of Highway 1 and the Duke Point Highway.





Proposed Timeline

2006 – 2009	City of Nanaimo Adopts the current Sandstone OCP Masterplan.
Seacliff Purchases Sandstone	
(November 2018)	
May 2019	Submission of the Official Community Plan Update Application; Meetings with the Chase River Community Association Executive; and Meetings with Snuneymuxw First Nation.
June 2019	Chase River Community Association Open House; and Introductory Open House.
July 2019	Rezoning Submission.
Summer 2019	Staff Review the Submission.
Fall -Winter 2019	Additional Public Engagement; and City of Nanaimo Consideration
2020 Onwards	Sandstone Development.
