BC Climate Targets

City of Nanaimo

- Reduce 2007 emissions by 3% by 2020
- Reduce 2007 emissions by 39% by 2050

City of Victoria

- 100 percent renewable energy by 2050
- Reduce our greenhouse gas emissions by 80% over 2007

City of Vancouver

- 2020 Targets: Reduce community-based greenhouse gas emissions by 33% from 2007 levels
- 2050 Targets: Reduce greenhouse gas emissions 80%

Climate Emergency: City of Nanaimo

City of Nanaimo declared a climate emergency and announced steps in place to protect its economy, eco systems and community.

Relevant steps included were:

- The creation of a reserve fund used to support projects, plans and initiatives that reduce the City's CO2 emissions
- An update to the City's Community Sustainability Action Plan, including the framework, strategies, actions and implementation.

Community Carbon Marketplace

The CCM is an online exchange to buy and sell community carbon credits generated from a wide range of greenhouse gas (GHG) emission reduction projects.

Projects include: Petroleum fuel switching to biofuels & electric vehicles, diverting organics from landfill, building retrofits, etc.

CCM Achievements:

- ~10,000 tonnes CO2e reduced through CCM
- 10 local government have utilized CCM
- UBCM Climate Action Award winner with City of Duncan
- Studied in France as a model for incentivising community emissions reductions
