

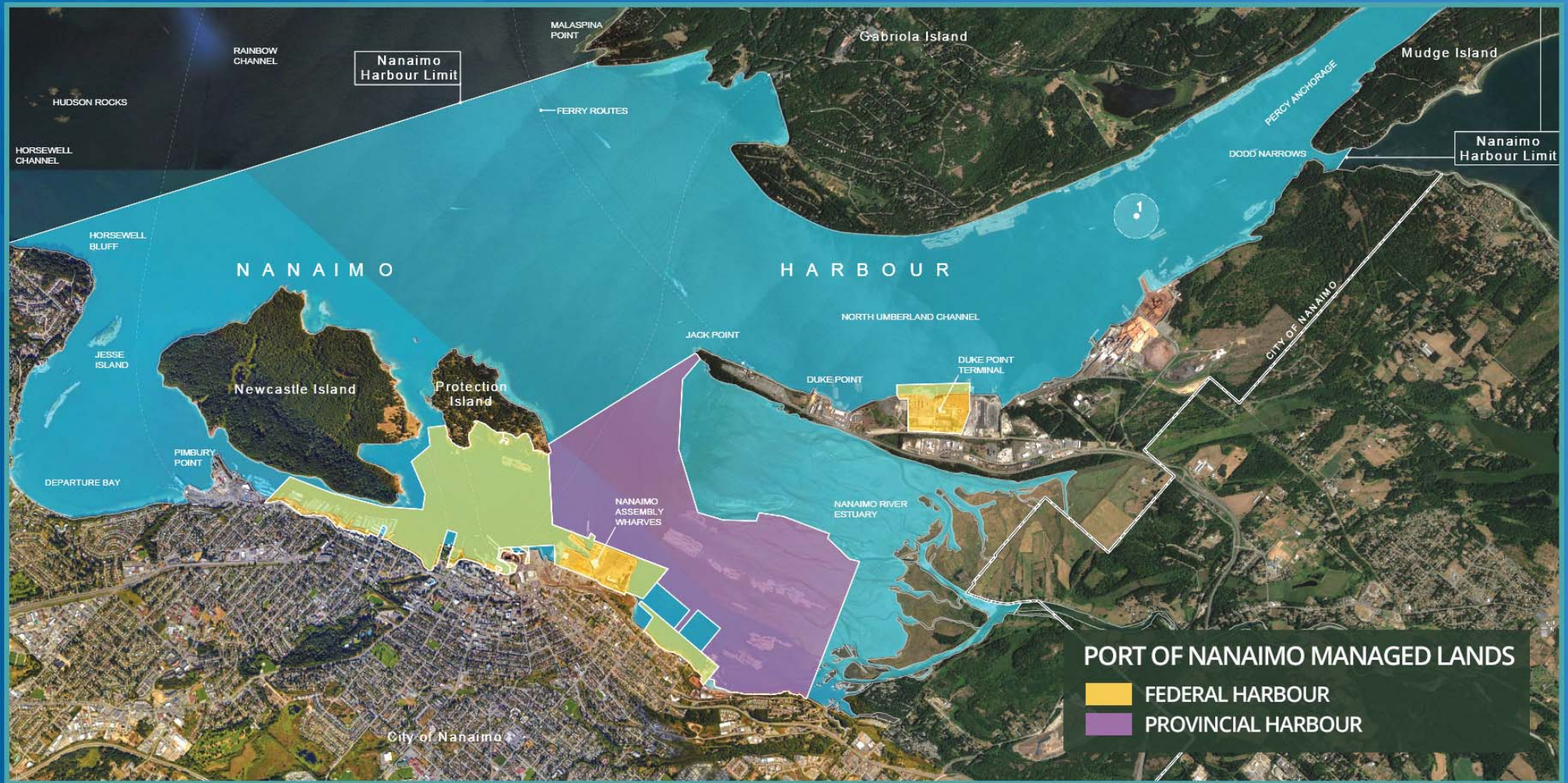

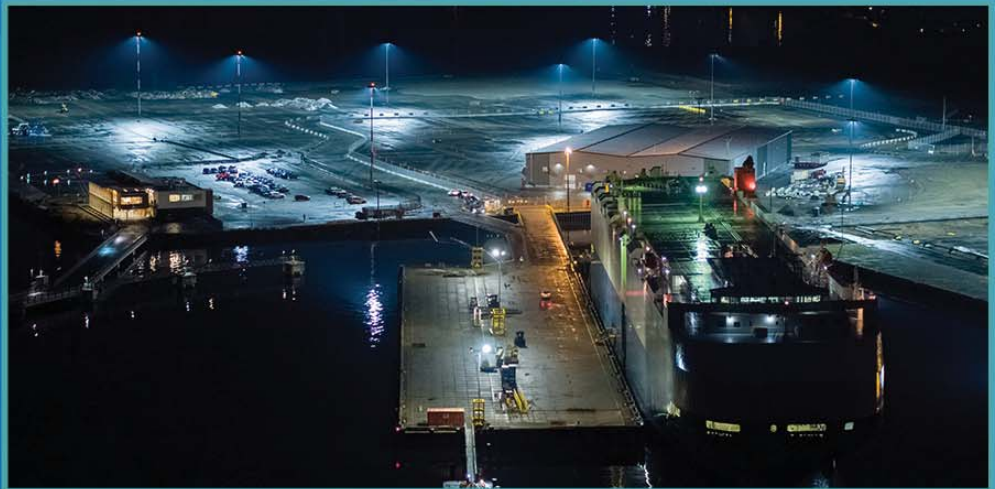

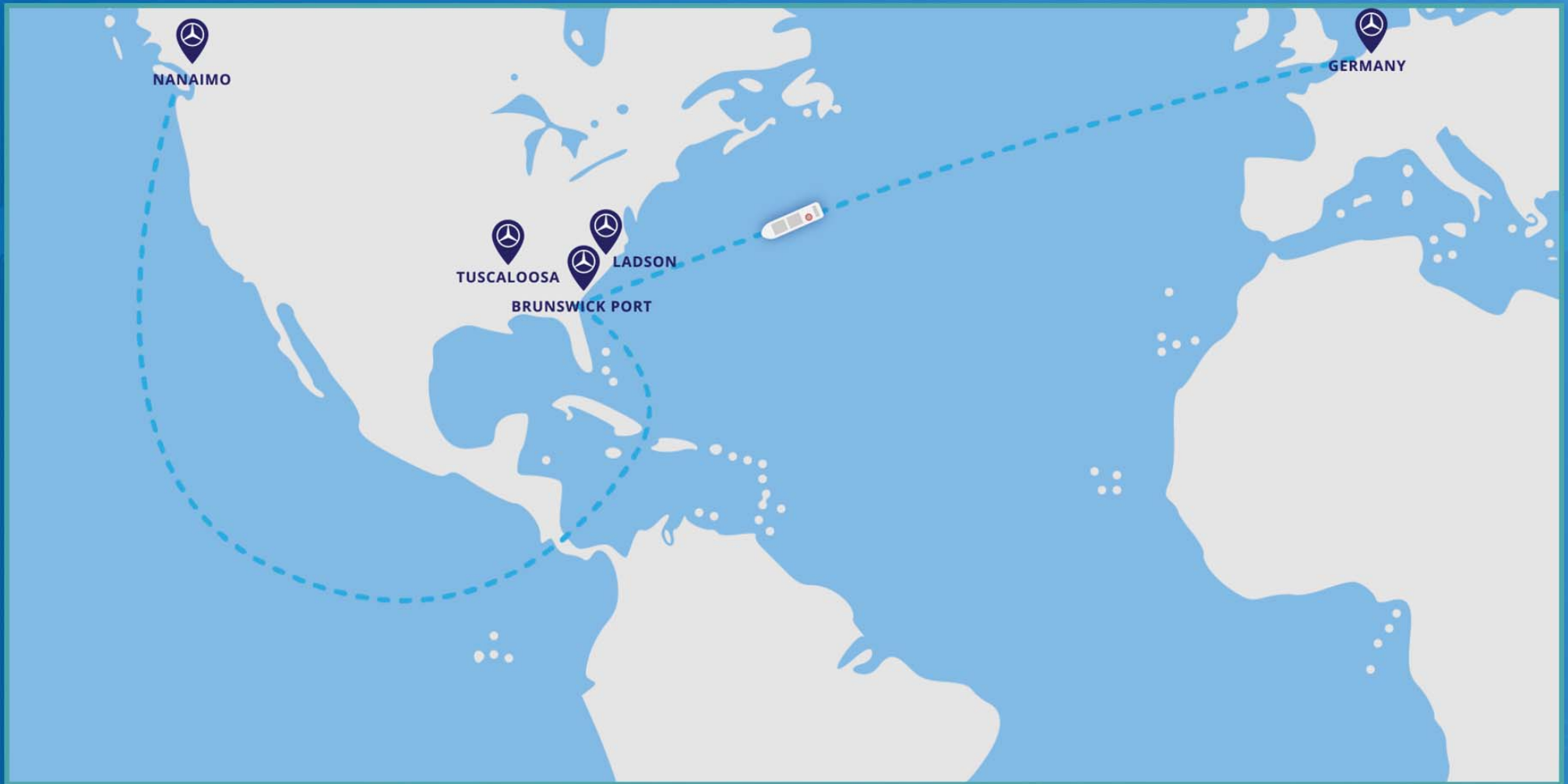
Duke Point Terminal

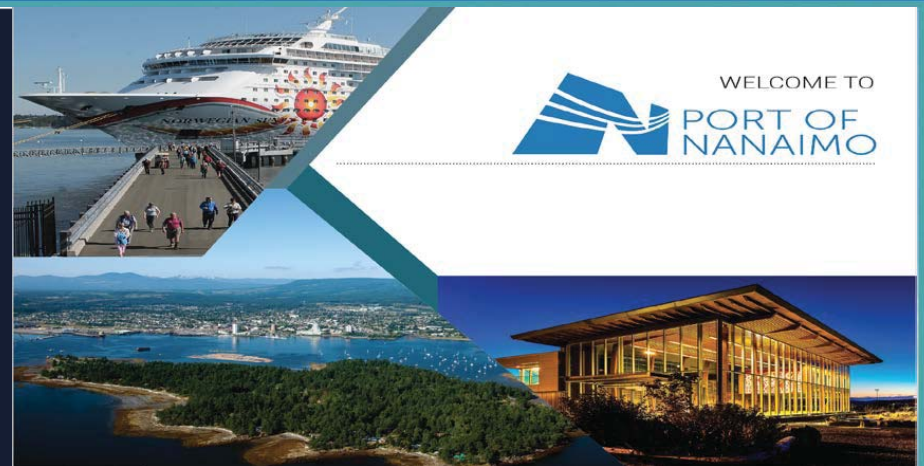
