Response may include consultation,  
assessment, referral and short-term  
follow up.

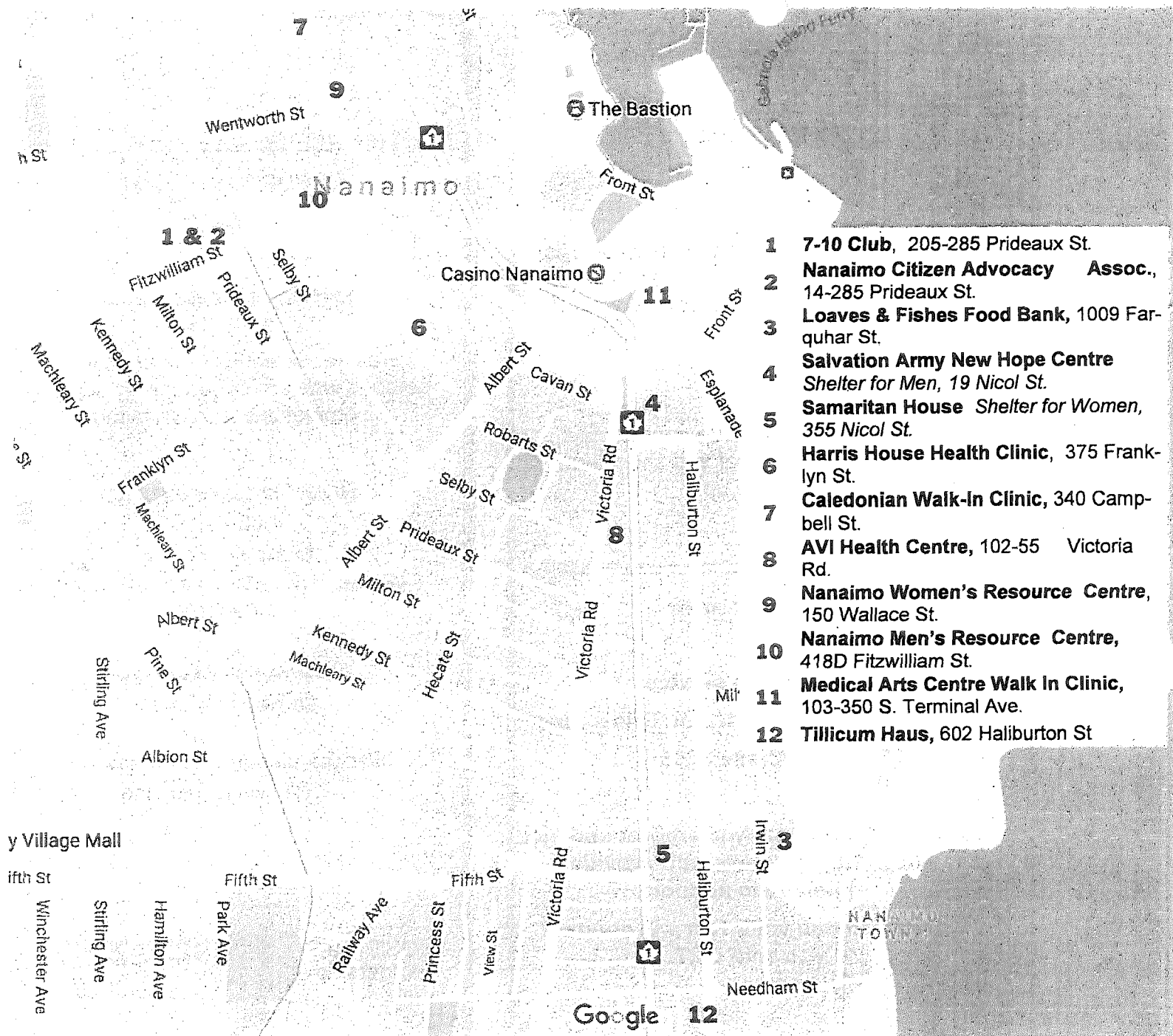
