# The Program

Temporary Public Art Program started in 2010

There are currently 169 public art projects to date in the inventory of Public Art (both temporary and permanent).



# The Process

**Sep 2017** Joint “Call to Artists” issued

**Nov 2017** 21 artists / teams submitted  
39 concepts

**Dec 2017** Art in Public Places  
Selection Panel

**Jan 2018** Council Approval

**May 2018** Installation of art during  
Public Art Week .

# The Criteria

- Quality of the proposal
- Quality of the submitted work
- Suitability and durability of the work
- Ability to meet public safety and vandalism considerations
- Addition of cultural vitality to the public space

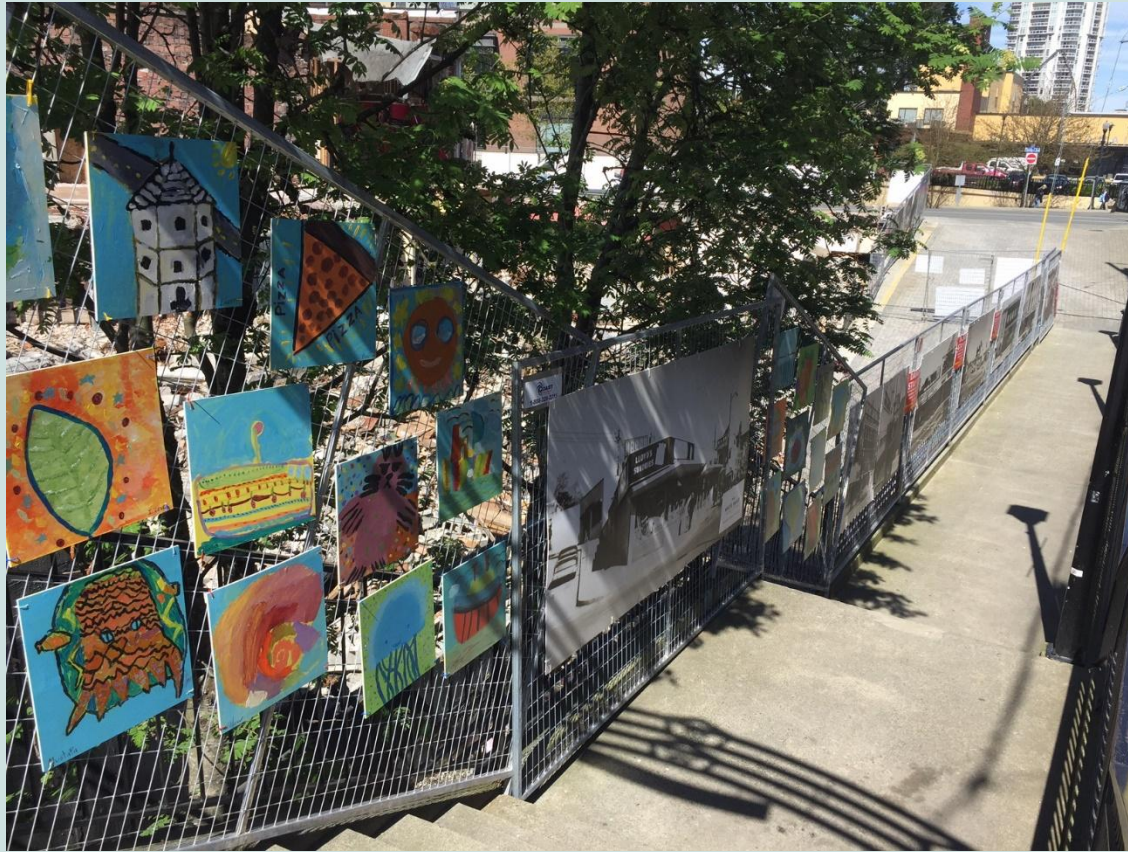

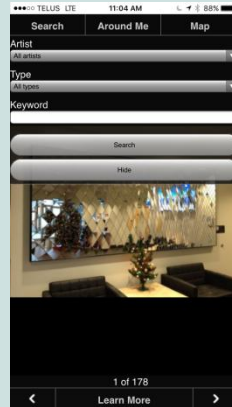
