



Committee Recommendations

- 1. Establish a Downtown Working Group coordinating stakeholders to support police, social responders & city efforts to promote a safer Downtown District.
- 2. Develop a Community Services Office that will focus the business community, private and public security personnel in a coordinated effort.
- 3. Zoning changes should be adopted to permit the development of social services in all commercial areas of the city.


