- Through a City-wide public process, determine public priorities for the corridor
- Balance these priorities against technical and physical constraints to develop a phased action plan towards achieving this balanced vision



- Number of vehicle lanes Mixed support


ABOUT THE PLAN


THE PLAN

STRATEGY FOR CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENTS

PROPOSED APPROACH VEHICLE TRAFFIC



- Infrastructure for 4 vehicle lanes
- Time-of-day parking
- Traffic calming:
 - Infill Tree Planting
 - Gateway Element
 - Curb Extensions on Cross Streets
 - Centre Medians
 - Cross-corridor Connections



PROPOSED APPROACH PEDESTRIAN REALM

- Pedestrian crosswalks, midblock crossings, cross-corridor connections
- Expanded pedestrian area
- Improvements to attractiveness of amenities



PROPOSED APPROACH CYCLING



- Parallel routes on Haliburton and Victoria
- Integrated cycling within the pedestrian area on Terminal
- Improved connections to and across Terminal Nicol
- End-of-trip facilities



PROPOSED APPROACH TRANSIT

- Regular transit on Nicol Street
- Future rapid transit
- High quality transit areas and amenities



PROPOSED APPROACH DEVELOPMENT


- Ensure strong design guidelines

- High quality spaces in front of businesses

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

SEGMENT I: SOUTH TO FARQUHAR






SEGMENT 2: FARQUHAR TO ESPLANADE





IMPLEMENTATION

HOW COULD COMPONENTS BE COMPLETED?



IMPLEMENTATION APPROACH

IMPLEMENTATION PACKAGES

- Critical Triggers What does the component need to be done before?
- Related Components What components should be grouped together for efficiency and greatest benefit?
- Pre-Requisites What components need to be done before the package is complete?
- Preliminary Budget Estimate What is the high-level cost to implement the package?

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR COUNCIL CONSIDERATION

- Direct city staff to undertake Component A: City Policy, Plans & Bylaw Review
- Direct city staff to begin discussions with MoTI to prepare terms of reference to complete Component B: Functional Design
