We, the residents of Nanaimo, request that the City take action to help clean up the unsightly amount of garbage that is found along our streets, alleys, bus stops and ditches littering our residential areas and by-ways. 3. Impose a garbage or "Litter" tax on convenience stores and fast food outlets to offset garbage removal, as most of the garbage comes from these businesses.

5. Spearhead a city wide 'Clean Up Nanaimo' campaign, an annual event which could call upon groups, organizations and all residents of Nanaimo to pick up garbage on a specified day.

6. Hire homeless and other less fortunate people, as those on welfare, to pick up garbage on a continuing basis.

7. Impose harsher fines and community hours in cleaning up the trash on those caught littering.

8. The need for better education around the issue of littering.

These are just a few ideas, and not all are supported by all citizens. However, the need to remedy the problem of unsightly garbage around our city is a serious concern.
