Why Should the Nanaimo Mosquito AAA Pirates Receive City Funding for Provincials?

### **Background**

- The Nanaimo Minor Baseball Association (NMBA) has partnered with the newly formed Serauxmen Stadium Amateur Baseball Association (SSADA) to operate and improve Serauxmen Stadium in partnership with the City of Nanaimo
- Minor Baseball in Nanaimo has a long, rich history of providing a sport where kids and young adults can dream of opportunities that can shape their lives
- The Nanaimo baseball system offers programs that offer something for everyone, ranging from beginner & house league programs to AAA programs

#### **Provincial Recognition**

- The AAA program offers the opportunity for Nanaimo to achieve Provincial recognition for our programs
- Players that participate in AAA programs learn the skills necessary to become successful adults and give back to the community as coaches and volunteers
- Players that continue in these programs can earn and receive College and University scholarships
  - In many cases, this can greatly assist players that have a financial need and would otherwise not be able to attend Post Secondary educational courses
- Achieving Provincial recognition attracts and encourages more children to be active and play the sport
- Provincial recognition also attracts economic benefits for Nanaimo.
  - o This includes:
    - More out-of-town baseball teams travelling to Nanaimo, staying at Nanaimo accommodations, and patronizing Nanaimo businesses
    - More opportunities to host major tournaments in Nanaimo

#### **Financial Need**

- Due to larger registration numbers in Nanaimo, the Nanaimo Mosquito Pirates are classified as a AAA team
  - The only other AAA team on Vancouver Island is in Victoria
- In order to play other teams of the same calibre, the Nanaimo AAA Mosquito Pirates must travel off of Vancouver Island in order to play teams at the same level
- The cost to the families involved is quite significant
- If it becomes too expensive to join the AAA team, we could lose participants in this program
