

Provincial Recognition

- The Nanaimo Tadpole Pirates recently won first place in the Regional Championship in Victoria, BC, and have a great opportunity to achieve recognition for Nanaimo Programs at the Provincials in Cloverdale
- Players that participate in organized sport learn the skills necessary to become successful adults and give back to the community as coaches and volunteers
- Players that continue in these programs can earn and receive College and University scholarships
 - In many cases, this can greatly assist players that have a financial need and would otherwise not be able to attend Post Secondary educational courses
- Achieving Provincial recognition attracts and encourages more children to be active and play the sport
- Provincial recognition also attracts economic benefits for Nanaimo.
 - o This includes:
 - More out-of-town baseball teams travelling to Nanaimo, staying at Nanaimo accommodations, and patronizing Nanaimo businesses
 - More opportunities to host major tournaments in Nanaimo

Financial Need

- In order to play other teams of the same calibre, the Nanaimo Tadpole A Pirates must travel off of Vancouver Island in order to play teams at the same level
- The cost to the families involved is quite significant
- If it becomes too expensive to join the all-star teams, we could lose participants in this program
