2015 / 2016	Construction design work proceeds on the project.
2015-JAN-02	Council support given to apply for funding support under the Federal Government's New Building Canada Fund but application ultimately not successful.
2014-SEP-08	<p>City Council receives summary of Port Theatre Society Community Consultation Process and approves the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Partnering with the Port Theatre Society on the project; • Proceeding with building a City owned facility on the existing Port Theatre Land with a project manager assigned by the City; • Allocating \$4.6 million financial contribution to the project dependent and conditional on the Society securing the remaining funds; and • Co-signing a \$2 million dollar line of credit in order to proceed with design and engineering completion.
2014-JAN-13	Letter submitted to Council by Port Theatre Society requesting Council support for Community Performing Arts Centre proposal community consultation process. Council directed staff to provide support to the Port Theatre Society's community consultation process providing information to the public with respect to the proposed Community Performing Arts Centre, as well as seek input and gauge community support for the addition's proposed design and function. Consultation process carried out in May and June, 2014 through three public engagement sessions and an online survey.
