SUBJECT APPOINTMENT OF BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER

OVERVIEW

Purpose of Report

To obtain Council approval to appoint Craig Dishkin as a Bylaw Enforcement Officer.

Recommendation

That Council appoint Craig Dishkin as a Bylaw Enforcement Officer to enforce provisions of the City of Nanaimo Bylaws.

BACKGROUND

Council may appoint new Bylaw Enforcement Officers by resolution, for the purposes of enforcing the municipality's bylaws pursuant to "Bylaw Enforcement Bylaw 1984 No. 2700".

Craig Dishkin has commenced employment with the City of Nanaimo Bylaw, Regulation and Security as a Bylaw Enforcement Officer – Parking Patrol, with duties to enforce City of Nanaimo Bylaws. This is a new position approved by Council to enhance downtown public safety and parking enforcement.

OPTIONS

1. That Council appoint Craig Dishkin as a Bylaw Enforcement Officer to enforce the provisions of the City of Nanaimo Bylaws.
2. That Council provide alternate direction.

SUMMARY POINTS

- New Bylaw Enforcement Officers must be appointed by Council resolution to enforce city bylaws.
- Craig Dishkin has commenced employment with the City and requires appointment as a Bylaw Enforcement Officer.
