SUBJECT APPOINTMENT OF BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER

OVERVIEW

Purpose of Report

To have Council appoint Mike Sherman as a Bylaw Enforcement Officer.

Recommendation

That Council appoint Mike Sherman as a Bylaw Enforcement Officer to enforce provisions of City of Nanaimo “Licencing and Control of Animals Bylaw 1995 No. 4923” and “Parks, Recreation and Culture Regulation Bylaw 2008 No. 7073”.

BACKGROUND

Council may appoint new Bylaw Enforcement Officers by resolution for the purposes of enforcing the municipality’s bylaws pursuant to “Bylaw Enforcement Bylaw 1984 No. 2700”.

Mike Sherman has commenced employment with Nanaimo Animal Control Services Ltd., the contractor that enforces the provisions of the “Licencing and Control of Animals Bylaw 1995 No. 4923” and “Parks, Recreation and Culture Bylaw 2008 No. 7073”, from time to time.

OPTIONS

1. That Council appoint Mike Sherman as a Bylaw Enforcement Officer to enforce provisions of City of Nanaimo “Licencing and Control of Animals Bylaw 1995 No. 4923” and “Parks and Recreation Culture Regulation Bylaw 2008 No. 7073”.
2. That Council provide alternative direction.

SUMMARY POINTS

- New Bylaw Enforcement Officers must be appointed by Council resolution to enforce City bylaws.
- Mike Sherman has commenced employment with Nanaimo Animal Control Services Ltd. and requires appointment as a Bylaw Enforcement Officer to enforce provisions of City of Nanaimo “Licencing and Control of Animals Bylaw 1995 No. 4923” and “Parks and Recreation Culture Regulation Bylaw 2008 No. 7073”.
