A BYLAW TO AMEND THE CITY OF NANAIMO "SIGN BYLAW 1987 NO. 2850"

---

WHEREAS the Council may regulate signs, by bylaw, pursuant to Sections 526 of the *Local Government Act*,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Municipal Council of the City of Nanaimo, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the "Sign Amendment Bylaw 2020 No. 2850.22".
2. The City of Nanaimo "Sign Bylaw 1987 No. 2850" is hereby amended as follows:

By deleting Subsection 6.(9) in Section 6 "Permit Exemptions", and replacing it with the following:

One non-illuminated freestanding or one non-illuminated facia sign per single residential dwelling for the purpose of advertising a home-based business or businesses provided the area of a sign does not exceed 0.2 m<sup>2</sup>.
