# **OVERVIEW**

# **Purpose of Report**

To obtain Council direction regarding a resolution for submission to the Association of Vancouver Island and Coastal Communities Convention.

#### Recommendation

That Council direct Staff to submit the following resolution to the Association of Vancouver Island and Coastal Communities for consideration at their 2020 Annual General Meeting:

WHEREAS the Association of Vancouver Island and Coastal Communities has created a Special Committee for Solid Waste:

AND WHEREAS developing a circular economy is a vital component of sustainable solid waste management:

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Association of Vancouver Island and Coastal Communities expand the terms of reference for their Special Committee on Solid Waste to include circular economy.

#### **BACKGROUND**

The Association of Vancouver Island and Coastal Communities (AVICC) 2020 Annual General Meeting will be held April 17-19, 2020 in Nanaimo. AVICC members are invited to submit resolutions on topics that fall under local government purview, are specific and focus on new issues of provincial or AVICC-wide interest. Resolutions that are endorsed at AVICC are automatically forwarded to the Union of British Columbia Municipalities (UBCM) conference for debate; however, as this resolution is specific to an AVICC committee, it would not be forwarded to UBCM.

At the Special Governance and Priorities Committee Meeting held 2020-JAN-20, the Governance and Priorities Committee passed the following motion:

It was moved and seconded that the Governance and Priorities Committee recommend that Council forward to the Association of Vancouver Island and Coastal Communities for consideration, a resolution to expand the mandate of AVICC Committee on Solid Waste to include "circular economy".



Staff have drafted a resolution for Council's consideration and are requesting Council's direction to proceed.

#### DISCUSSION

The deadline to submit resolutions to AVICC is Thursday, February 6, 2020.

## **OPTIONS**

1. That Council direct Staff to submit the following resolution to the Association of Vancouver Island and Coastal Communities for consideration at their 2020 Annual General Meeting:

WHEREAS the Association of Vancouver Island and Coastal Communities has created a Special Committee for Solid Waste;

AND WHEREAS developing a circular economy is a vital component of sustainable solid waste management;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Association of Vancouver Island and Coastal Communities expand the terms of reference for their Special Committee on Solid Waste to include circular economy.

- The advantages of this option: The draft resolution will be forwarded to AVICC within the deadline.
- The disadvantages of this option: If Council wishes to make changes to the resolution, any changes would need to be made at the Council meeting due to the upcoming AVICC resolution deadline.
- Financial Implications: There are no financial implications identified at this time.
- 2. That Council provide alternative direction.
  - The advantages of this option: Council may wish to adjust the wording of the draft resolution.
  - The disadvantages of this option: The deadline for submission is Thursday, February 6, 2020 and any changes would need to be made during the Council meeting.
  - Financial Implications: There are no financial implications identified at this time.
