



Role of the Medical Health Officer

- Statutory
 - Requirements under Public Health Act & other laws
- Population Health
 - Monitoring and assessing health status of community
- Community Medicine Consultant
 - Providing evidence-based opinions
 - Working collaboratively to assist in resolving issues
- Advocacy
 - Communicating directly on health issues affecting community (media, board, elected officials, etc.)



Office of the Provincial Health Officer

Status: COVID-19 on Vancouver Island

(as of 25 August 2020)

- ~170 cases in 170 days
- Population = ~850,000
- Cases per million = 200
- 45,000 tests performed = 0.4% positivity
- Assume for every detected case, 8 are not detected (<u>BCCDC serology study</u>): 200 * 8 = 1,600 cases
- 1,600 cases / 850,000 population = 0.19% infected
- Since July, 5 cases with possible acquisition in the community
 - Vancouver Island has a very low rate of COVID-19
 - Vancouver Island has very little community transmission
