SUBJECT APPOINTMENT OF BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER

OVERVIEW

Purpose of Report

To recommend that Council appoint Mark Jonah, currently an Inspector with the Nanaimo Fire Rescue Department, as a Bylaw Enforcement Officer.

Recommendation

That Council pass a resolution to appoint Mark Jonah as Bylaw Enforcement Officer to enforce the provisions of the City of Nanaimo “Fire Protection and Life Safety Regulation Bylaw 2011 No. 7108” and other regulatory bylaws.

BACKGROUND

Council may appoint new Bylaw Enforcement Officers by resolution for the purposes of enforcing the municipality’s bylaws pursuant to “Bylaw Enforcement Bylaw 1984 No. 2700”.

Mark Jonah is an inspector in the Fire Rescue Department’s Fire and Loss Prevention Section, with duties to enforce City of Nanaimo “Fire Protection and Life Safety Regulation Bylaw 2011 No. 7108”, and other regulatory bylaws.

OPTIONS

1. That Council pass a resolution to appoint Mark Jonah as Bylaw Enforcement Officer to enforce the provisions of the City of Nanaimo “Fire Protection and Life Safety Regulation Bylaw 2011 No. 7108” and other regulatory bylaws.
2. That Council provide alternative direction.

SUMMARY POINTS

- Fire Rescue Department personnel must be appointed as Bylaw Enforcement Officers by Council resolution to enforce City bylaws.
- Mark Jonah is a Fire Rescue Department Inspector and requires Bylaw Enforcement Officer appointment to enforce the “Fire Protection and Life Safety Regulation Bylaw 2011 No. 7108” and other regulatory bylaws.
