SUBJECT MAYOR'S LEADERS' TABLE – TERMS OF REFERENCE

OVERVIEW

Purpose:

To obtain approval for the Mayor's Leaders' Table Terms of Reference.

Recommendation

That Council approve the Mayor's Leaders' Table Terms of Reference.

BACKGROUND

Consistent with the 2020 Mayor's Task Force on Recovery and Resilience Recommendations, and Council's direction to establish a Mayor's Leaders' Table (the Table) to advise, inform and collaborate across the community to further Nanaimo's opportunities and address challenges, this report presents the draft Terms of Reference for approval.

DISCUSSION

Broad community engagement at the Table, leveraging community-wide resources under the leadership of the City, constructs a forum to align the community strategically for multi-level government capital infrastructure asks, establish a youth attraction and retention strategy, build collaboration across entities, garner timely input, and, create an opportunity for broader implementation of the Doughnut Economics philosophy.

OPTIONS

- 1. That Council approve the Mayor's Leaders' Table Terms of Reference.
 - The advantages of this option: Convening and operationalization of the Table commences.
 - The disadvantages of this option: None.
 - Financial Implications: Nominal meeting annual expense budget totalling \$12,000 required.
- 2. That Council provide alternate direction.
 - The advantages of this option: Council improves the Terms of Reference.



- The disadvantages of this option: None.
- Financial Implications: Same as Option 1 if Table operationalized.
