BYLAW NO. 1231.08

A BYLAW TO AMEND REGIONAL DISTRICT OF NANAIMO REGIONAL PARKS AND TRAILS SERVICE AREA CONVERSION BYLAW NO. 1231

WHEREAS the Board of the Regional District of Nanaimo wishes to amend “Regional District of Nanaimo Regional Parks and Trails Service Area Conversion Bylaw No. 1231, 2001”;

AND WHEREAS at least 2/3 of the service participants have consented to the adoption of this bylaw in accordance with the *Local Government Act*;

NOW THEREFORE the Board of the Regional District of Nanaimo, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Citation

This bylaw may be cited as the “Regional District of Nanaimo Regional Parks and Trails Service Area Amendment Bylaw No. 1231.08, 2021”.

2. Amendment

“Regional District of Nanaimo Regional Parks and Trails Service Area Conversion Bylaw No. 1231, 2001” is amended as follows:

(1) By deleting Section 6 in its entirety, and replacing it with the following:

6. Apportionment

The annual costs of the service shall be apportioned among the participating areas as follows:

(a) The annual costs for operations and maintenance shall be apportioned among the participating areas on the basis of the combination of:

- (i) Fifty (50) percent of converted assessment; and
- (ii) Fifty (50) percent of the proportionate share of the population of each of the participating areas to the total population of all of the participating areas.

(b) The annual costs for acquisitions and capital development shall be apportioned among the participating areas on the basis of the combination of:

- (i) Fifty (50) percent of converted assessment; and
- (ii) Fifty (50) percent of the proportionate share of the population of each of the participating areas to the total population of all of the participating areas.

(c) Population referenced in Subsections 6 (a) and 6 (b) shall be as reported through the most recent census conducted by Statistics Canada (or any agency or Ministry that replaces Statistics Canada in the function of the collection of population statistics in Canada).

(2) By deleting Section 7 in its entirety and renumbering the subsequent section accordingly.
