## Advisory Committee on Accessibility and Inclusiveness Outstanding Recommendations

## May 26, 2021

It was moved and seconded that:

- ... the ACAI recommend that Council and municipal staff adopt the use of pronouns in all written and electronic communications.
- . . . the City of Nanaimo use gender-inclusive and gender-neutral language, including communications, print and electronic materials.
- ... the ACAI recommend that the City of Nanaimo update and revise all print and electronic materials to include the use of gender-inclusive and gender-neutral language.
- ... the ACAI recommend that the City of Nanaimo arrange for the availability of diversity and inclusion training for Council members and City staff. This would include both LGBTQIA2+ and gender competency training, either online or in-person workshops, or both.

## November 25, 2020

It was moved and seconded that:

- ... Council defer consideration of the following motions and direct staff to prepare a report:
  - 1. That Council direct Staff to prepare a bylaw, which prevents garbage cans and recycling cans from being placed on sidewalks, in order to improve accessibility to the City of Nanaimo.
  - 2. That Council direct Staff to make all transit stops within the City of Nanaimo uniform and highly visible so they are accessible for all citizens.
