Re: Development at Highway 1/Maki Road

The Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure (MOTI, the ministry) has been in consultation with the City of Nanaimo regarding the OCP Ammendment and development of sites on the southeast quadrant of the intersection of Highway 1 with Tenth/Maki Roads.

This letter is to inform you that the ministry is not in favour of supporting the proposed development as proposed. Traffic impact assessments of the signal at Highway 1/10th/Maki indicate that capacity at the signal is approaching capacity, with sideroad levels of service at E and D, respectively for 10th and Maki as of 2018. Further vehicle loading at the intersection will fail multiple movements and create additional congestion both on side roads and highway movements.

Additionally, the new proposed road across from the access to Rona does not provide sufficient stacking or storage length from the highway intersection to ensure that operational issues will not affect operations and safety at the highway. Further to this point, MOTI will not consider closing the current frontage road Right of Way to facilitate this road dedication.
