	Our purpose is to provide a space with tools and equipment to enable members of
	our community to participate in hobbies and learning activities including, but not limited to, woodworking, electronics, robotics, 3D printing, Laser cutting, and metal working.
2.	Please list the programs and services provided by your organization.
	MakeTime For Kids: youngsters are introduced to electronics including basic programming as well as robotics and beginner woodworking.
	Outreach: We provide assistance to other local not for profit groups such as the South End Community Association by way of our volunteers using their woodworking skills and out equipment to make signage for Heritage designated houses. We are also assisting the Nanaimo Radio Club with meeting space and equipment. We also support special needs adults registered with an existing outreach program through Community Living BC (CLBC) who are brought in for industrial workplace training through the introduction of hand and power tools. This is conducted by a fully qualified member volunteer.
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3.	Are you planning to change or add to current programs and services in the future?
	Yes. As the Covid threat diminishes the MakeTime For Kids program will be run on monthly basis. We also expect that our free "Drop in" nights will once again become popular.
	With a brand new suite of wood working power tools courtesy of New Horizons for Seniors we are looking at starting programs aimed at getting our local seniors involved in wood working training and activities as a volunteer program.
4.	Please describe the role of volunteers in your organization.
	Our volunteers use their skills and experience to mentor others and to provide volunteer services where appropriate. We welcome all members of our community and are always looking for ways that we can use our talents and equipment to the betterment of the
	community.
5.	Please list all grants received from the City of Nanaimo, Regional District of Nanaimo, and
	other governments or service clubs.
	We have received one grant from the New Horizons For Seniors for our "Wood Working
	Shop Upgrade Program" in the amount of \$25,000. This money is being used to purchase
	a full suite of power wood working tools and will greatly facilitate our current programs as well as adding new ones. Please note that these funds have been included in our current
	budget as a one time income and expense and will be fully expended prior to year end.

	Membership can be purchased at \$50/mth or \$500/yr. Our fee structure is set to cover our operating expenses such as rent and utilities with a small margin for repairs and
	maintenance of our equipment and is based on membership numbers.
	We are projecting that as the Covid threat decreases and our newly equipped wood shop goes into operation, we will see an increase in membership which could result in a
	decrease of membership fees.

	We are tenants in our space and do not sub-let any of our space.

	Our self generated income is primarily through small membership fees as noted
	previously. We charge a small fee for training and certification on our more expensive
	and complicated equipment such as the Laser cutter and the CNC machine, This training is open to non members at the same low rate as for members at \$50 for each
	machine.

Makerspace is now in its 8th year in Nanaimo. We have and continue to provide a Covid safe environment for all members of the community with emphasis on our seniors who are most at risk of the detrimental effects of isolation. Our facility is open 24/7 for our members and it is an ideal way to meet new friends, be active in a hobby, and continue the learning experience.


