

Corporation of the City of Kauaimo B. C.

A By Law to close Barber shops during the hours of Sunday.

Whereas it is provided by the Municipal clauses Amendment Act 1899, that the Municipal Council of any Municipality may pass by-laws for prohibiting the keeping open of Barber's shops on Sundays, and

Whereas the Municipal Council of the City of Kauaimo has been petitioned to pass a by-law to prohibit the keeping open of Barber shops during Sundays within the limits of the said city.

Be it therefore enacted by the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Kauaimo as follows:-

- 1 From and after the passage of this By-Law it shall not be lawful for any person or persons to open, permit to be opened or kept open any barber shop in the City of Kauaimo, between the hours of 12 o'clock midnight on Saturday and 12 o'clock midnight on Sunday in each week, under a penalty of not less than five dollars nor more than twenty-five dollars together with the costs of conviction for each offence
- 2 This By Law may be cited for all purposes as the Barber's Shop Sunday Closing By Law 1899
