CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NANAIMO.B.C.

Whereas it is deemed expedient to provide for the watering or sprinkling of certain streets in the City of Nanaime, upon which stores and other business premises have been erected, viz:—Nicol street from Crace street northward to Victoria Crescent, Victoria Crescent, Commercial street, Church street, Dallas Square to its intersection with Front street, Chapel street from the northerly boundary of let 14 in Block 54 to Commercial street, Bastion street from its intersection with Front street to the Bastion street bridge, and Skinner street between Bastion and Commercial streets;

Be it therefore enacted by the Mayer and Aldermen of the City of Nanaimo as fellows:-

- 1. There shall be levied and collected from the occupiers of all stores and premises of every kind fronting upon any of the streets above named, and within the limits above recited, the sum of Two and a half cents per foot frontage, per month, during the months of June, July, August and September in each and every year.
- 2. The above sum of Two and a half cents per foot frontage, per month, shall be due and payable to the Collector of the Corperation, at his office in the City Hall, on the 7th day of the following month for which it is due, viz: the 7th July, 7th August, 7th September and the 7th October, and all persons who shall pay the the respective amounts due and payable by them on or before the aforementioned days, shall be entitled to a rebate of ten per cent of the amount due by them.
- 3. This By-Law may be cited for all purposes, as the Street Sprink-ling By-Law, 1906.
