A B Y - L A W .

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary to amend the "Public Health By-Law 1890".

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Municipal Council of the City of Nanaimo as follows:-

- ( 1 ) The Public Health By-Law 1890 is hereby amended by adding after Section 37 the following:-
- ( a ) Any person who shall keep swine within the limits of the City of Nanaimo shall keep the yard and premises clean and sanitary at all times, to the satisfaction of the Sanitary Inspector.
- ( b ) No pen for pigstys shall be erected or built, or if erected or built shall be allowed to remain save with the consent of the Medical Health Officer previously had and obtained, within fifty (50) feet of any dwelling house.

This By-Law may be cited as "The Corporation of the City of Nanaimo Public Health Amendment By-Law No 306 1918."

Passed the Municipal Council this 11th day of February 1918.
