

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NANAIMO B.C.

BY - LAW No 309.

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary to amend the "Public Health By-Law 1890".

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED, by the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of Nanaimo as follows:-

- (1) The Public Health Amendment By-Law No. 21 1890 is hereby repealed.
- (2) Section 43 of the Public Health By-Law 1890 is hereby repealed and the following enacted in lieu thereof:-

"Scavengers so licensed shall have painted on their waggon or conveyance their name and number of their license in large letters and figures, and for night work shall carry a lighted lamp with the number painted on it, and they shall receive as a remuneration for their services from each householder up to and including Five (5) Persons the sum of Seventy-Five (75) cents per month, for every two (2) persons over (5) as mentioned above the sum of Twenty-Five (25) cents extra.

This By-Law may be cited as "The Corporation of the City of Nanaimo Public Health Amendment By-Law No 309 1918".

Passed by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of Nanaimo on the 10th day of June 1918.
