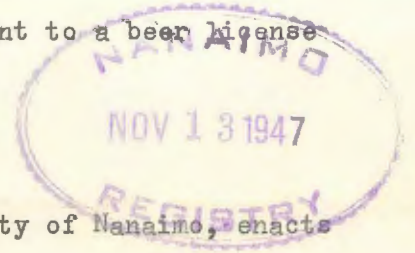


THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NANAIMO

BY-LAW NO. 717



A By-law to impose a tax, pursuant to Section 312A of the "Municipal Act," on persons carrying on business within this Municipality pursuant to a beer license issued under the "Government Liquor Act."



The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of Nanaimo, enacts as follows:

1. Every person carrying on business within this Municipality pursuant to a beer license issued under the "Government Liquor Act" shall pay to the Collector of this Municipality a tax of the amount prescribed in the "Municipal Act".
2. The said tax for each current year shall be paid on or before the thirty-first day of March in that year.
3. Any person guilty of an infraction of this By-law, shall be liable upon conviction, to a penalty not exceeding Fifty Dollars and costs; which penalty and costs shall be recoverable and enforceable upon summary conviction in the manner provided by the "Summary Convictions Act".
4. This By-law may be cited as the "BEER-LICENSE TAX BY-LAW 1947, NO. 717".
