THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NANAIMO

BY-LAW NO. 788

NANAIMO A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE THAT THE LIST OF VOTERS OF THE MUNICIPALITY (1950) SHALL BE DIVIDED INTO TWO PARTS.

The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of Nanaimo in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

- The annual list of voters of the Municipality shall be divided into two parts as follows:
 - Part One shall contain the names of all voters owning land or land and improvements in the Municipality.
 - (b) Part Two shall contain the names of all other voters.
- The names in each Part shall be listed alphabetically and 2. numbered consecutively throughout such Part and there shall be stated in a separate column under what qualification each voter is entitled to vote, as follows:
 - The letter "F" shall be used to designate voters qualifying as "Freemen" in the Municipality.
 - The letter "O" shall be used to designate voters owning land or land and improvements in the Municipality.
 - (c) The letter "H" shall be used to designate voters qualifying as "Householders" in the Municipality.
 - The letter "L" shall be used to designate voters qualifying (d) as "License Holders" in the Municipality.
- This By-law may be cited as the "VOTERS LIST BY-LAW 1950 3. NO. 788".
