## **OVERVIEW**

### **Purpose of Report**

## **BACKGROUND**

Council may appoint new Bylaw Enforcement Officers by resolution, for the purposes of enforcing the municipality's bylaws pursuant to "Bylaw Enforcement Bylaw 1984 No. 2700".

## **OPTIONS**

1. That Council appoint Grant Love as a Bylaw Enforcement Officer to enforce the provisions of the City of Nanaimo Regulatory Bylaws.
2. That Council provide alternate direction.

## **SUMMARY POINTS**

- New Bylaw Enforcement Officers must be appointed by Council resolution to enforce City Bylaws.
- Grant Love has commenced employment with the City and requires appointment as a Bylaw Enforcement Officer in order to take enforcement action.
