All rates charged, as set out above shall be due and payable when levied which shall be subject to a discount of five (5) percent, provided rates for the current billing period are paid in full including all arrears then outstanding into the Office of the Collector, or their agents, on or before the close of business on the date set out in the billing form.
- 3. Interim bills based on estimated water consumption (for volumetric sewer rate purposes) may be levied and collected between billing periods.
