- ▶ Proposed agenda structure matches the 5 goals of City Plan:





Highlights of 2023-FEB-13 GPC Discussion

- ▶ Desire to use GPC over establishing additional committees.
- ▶ Ensuring diverse membership is embedded into committee terms of reference.
- ▶ Strong support for Town Hall/e-Town Halls:
 - Provide additional opportunities for public participation.
 - Important that topics align with public interests/concerns



Options for Discussion

That the Governance and Priorities Committee recommend that Council:

- ▶ Utilize the Governance and Priorities Committee in place of additional Committees for monitoring the City Plan and other matters that the Committee would like to have more focused time on;
- ▶ Implement Quarterly Town Hall meetings for emerging matters of interest to the public; and,
- ▶ Dissolve the Environment Committee noting that matters considered by this committee would be identified and dealt with under the City Plan Integrated Action Plan - Green Nanaimo.

AND/OR

- ▶ Strike monitoring committees to meet bi-annually to monitor progress implementing the City Plan Integrated Action Plans; and/or,
- ▶ Strike other Committees over and above existing Committees.
