- The RDN is comprised of 4 municipalities, 7
 Electoral Areas and is the traditional
 territory of the Coast Salish peoples.
- Partnership with BC Transit through an Annual Operating Agreement (AOA).
- 74 buses and a workforce of approximately 150 people.


System Overview Continued

- Conventional system operates 137,800 annual service hours, with 55 Buses and 4 Community Buses
- Custom system operates 27,500 annual service hours with 15 buses
- 20 "fixed" transit routes from Deep Bay to Duncan and HandyDart within the Nanaimo, and Parksville-Qualicum Beach areas.
