

VIMM FACTS

- Incorporated in 1986 as a non-profit society.
- Member of Federal (OMCC) and Provincial (BCMA) Museum societies.
- Registered under the BC Societies Act
- Grew from 3500 to 5000 sq. ft. with move to current location
- VIMM contributed over \$30K in upgrades, fire alarm system, lighting, etc. at current location.
- VIMM pays rent to the City of Nanaimo (42,000 per year)
- Financially independent
- 35 personnel (all volunteers)
- Open 5 days a week
- Over 60 displays and exhibits


