PUBLIC NOTICE AND COMMENT SHEET

The City of Nanaimo has received notice of an application to the Provincial Liquor & Cannabis Regulation Branch (LCRB) for a liquor primary licence to allow liquor to be served at a cultural facility located at 2373 Rosstown Road.

The primary focus of the business is local entertainment and liquor service. The business would have a maximum capacity of 302 persons. The proposed hours of service are 12:00pm to 12:00am, seven days a week. If approved, the liquor primary licence would permit liquor to be served at the Bailey Studio, operated by the Nanaimo Theatre Group. As part of the review process, the City is responsible for gathering the views of local residents and business operators and to forward this information, along with recommendations, to the LCRB.

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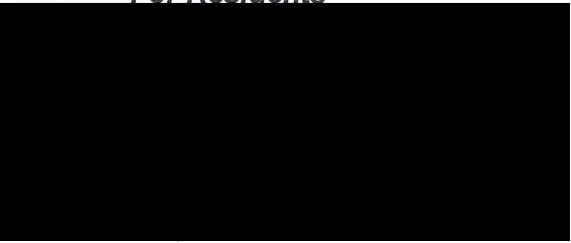

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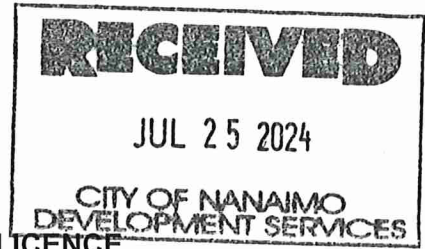
