BYLAW NO. 7128.16

A BYLAW TO AMEND THE MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE COLLECTION BYLAW

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Nanaimo may, in accordance with the *Community Charter*, exercise its authority in relation to the use of waste disposal and recycling services, and impose fees and charges thereto:

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Nanaimo in open meeting assembled, hereby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

Title

1. This Bylaw may be cited as “Municipal Solid Waste Collection Amendment Bylaw 2024 No. 7128.16”.

Amendments

2. “Municipal Solid Waste Collection Bylaw 2011 No. 7128” is hereby amended as follows:
 - (1) By deleting Schedule “A” in its entirety and substituting with the attached Schedule “A”.
 - (2) By deleting Section 17(3) in its entirety and replacing it with the following:
 - (3) Fees for the Municipal Solid Waste Collection System shall be levied from the earlier of;
 - (a) one month from the date of a City occupancy permit; or
 - (b) the date the carts are delivered by the City; or
 - (c) the date of actual occupancy of a premises

Effective Date

3. This Bylaw shall take effect on January 1, 2025.

SCHEDULE 'A'

RATES AND CHARGES

1. Solid waste collection fees are as follows:

i. Solid Waste Collection Fee	Daily Charge
Per dwelling unit (or equivalent) – Residential,	\$0.66027
Commercial or other premises receiving this service	
Additional fee for each garbage cart upsize	\$0.30411
ii. Cart Exchange & Additional Recycling carts	Per occurrence
Per 1 or more cart exchanged (at the same time) and	\$60.00
per request for additional recycling cart	
iii. Bin Replacement	Per occurrence
Due to loss, damage or disposal of bin*	Actual cost
iv. Cart Replacement/Repair Call Out Fee	Per occurrence
For requests to replace/repair a cart that, under the	\$60
opinion of the <i>General Manager, Engineering and</i>	
<i>Public Works</i> , is not in need or replacement or repair	

*The bin replacement fee may be waived in the event the loss or damage to the cart is not due to neglect and is not a repeat occurrence

2. The Solid Waste Collection Fees shall be due and payable when levied which shall be subject to a discount of five (5) percent provided rates for the current billing period are paid in full including arrears then outstanding into the office of the Collector or their agents, on or before the close of business on the date set out on the billing form.
