

- The shadows cast from this development are largest in the Spring months.
- The shadows throughout the day are cast largest in the morning.
- The shadows are cast less in the afternoon as the sun is higher.
- There appears to be little shadows cast onto the Ambulatory Care building and Palliative Care Unit.
- The entry to the new Cancer Centre gains some early morning sun and throughout the day is shaded, which will help solar heat gain and increase efficiency on mechanical systems for cooling.
