


Form and Character Design Guideline Project



Form and Character Design Guidelines

General Design Guidelines

 The General Design Guidelines apply to all commercial, industrial, multi-unit, intensive residential and mixed-use development in any land use designation, and set the expectations for site, building and landscape design.

Design Guidelines for Land Use Designations


 In addition, the design guidelines for land use designations will reinforce the unique form and character envisioned in City Plan for each land use designation.



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- Durable, quality materials
- Optimal building orientation
- Efficient thermal envelope
- Strategic window placement
- Solar shading devices
- Reduce thermal bridging
- Reduce carbon footprint
- Renewable energy capture





Updates to Zoning Bylaw Part 17 – Landscaping

- Keep in the Zoning Bylaw simplified requirements for landscape buffers, waste management enclosure setbacks, and maintenance requirements.
- Move to the new Form and Character Design Guidelines elements of fencing standards, landscape treatment and screening guidelines, and allow for site specific landscape solutions.
- Move to the Development Procedures and Notification Bylaw No. 7375 landscape restoration and security requirements, with updated practices, and a clear security release schedule.

Next Steps

April 2025 – GPC review of proposed Form and Character Design Guidelines, and direction to Staff to prepare amending bylaws.

May 2025 - Council consideration of proposed amending bylaw(s) to replace DPA8 form and character design guidelines and to amend the landscape regulations.

June 2025 - Hold a Public Hearing for proposed Zoning Amendment Bylaw, and Council consideration of adoption of proposed amending bylaw(s).

July-Sept. 2025 - Implementation of new Form and Character Design Guidelines.
